

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Vice-Mayor Long. Prayer was offered by Jim Thomas.

On a motion by Driver, seconded by Garrett, the minutes of the February 13 meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 97-541, an ordinance to amend Title II of the Municipal Code by amending Chapter 11, Section II-1104, Table VII. The City Manager stated that an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance requires a public hearing and that notice of a public hearing was not published in the newspaper. Motion by Garrett to defer action so that a public hearing can be held before second reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

Consider on second reading and public hearing Ordinance No. 97-542, an ordinance to rezone from R40 to Low Density Residential Planned Unit Development the property at Sumner County Tax Map 143 Parcel 80. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Vice-Mayor declared the public hearing closed. Motion by Thomas to pass Ordinance No. 97-542 on second and final reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

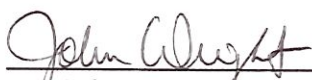
Commissioner Driver congratulated City employees Kerry Jackson and Jimmy Anderson who have recently become fathers.

Commissioner Thomas reiterated the statements the City Manager made at the Chamber of Commerce luncheon today when he said that Goodlettsville is a special community, as most recently evidenced by its response in support of the families whose sons were injured in a traffic accident this morning.

The City Manager presented a resolution urging the repeal of the statutory depreciation tables for personal property which the Tennessee Municipal League has asked all cities to adopt to reduce the loss of property tax revenue from utilities. Motion by Garrett to adopt Resolution No. R97-181 and have copies sent to our elected representatives and state officials. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

The City Manager announced that Senator Bill Frist will conduct a community meeting at City Hall on Friday, March 7, from 4:00 to 5:30 p.m. He also reminded everyone of the Board Members Dinner at the Pool Building next Tuesday at 6:00 p.m.

The meeting adjourned at 6:47 p.m.
