The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Ron Filson.

On a motion by Long, seconded by Driver, the minutes of the September 26 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

Former City commissioner Miles Frost administered the oath of office to newly elected commissioner Jim Thomas. City Judge Rob Wheeler administered the oath of office to reelected commissioners Johnny Long and Jim Driver. The Mayor stated his appreciation to Ron Filson for his eight years of service on the commission and congratulated the winners in the recent city election, and Jim Thomas took Ron Filson's seat at the rostrum. Commissioners Long, Driver, and Garrett also expressed their appreciation to Ron Filson and welcomed Jim Thomas to the commission. Commissioner Thomas stated that he hoped that he could come close to filling the shoes of Ron Filson and thanked all the candidates for a good, clean campaign.

The Mayor opened the floor for nominations for Mayor. Motion by Long to nominate Bobby Jones. Seconded by Garrett. A motion by Thomas that the nominations cease was seconded by Driver. The motion to elect Bobby Jones as Mayor passed 4-0. The Mayor opened the floor for nominations for Vice-Mayor. Motion by Driver to nominate Johnny Long. Seconded by Garrett. A motion by Thomas that the nominations cease was seconded by Garrett. The motion to elect Johnny Long as Vice-Mayor passed 4-0. Both the Mayor and Vice-Mayor thanked the commission for the privilege of serving another term.

State Representative and Metro Councilman Tim Garrett congratulated the newly elected commissioners and introduced Nashville Electric Service Public Relations Director Bill Beard, who asked that the commissioners feel free to call him with any problems related to electric service.

Commissioner Garrett asked that the City Attorney and Tim Garrett check into the situation regarding the misleading statements of the State Archaeologist which resulted in stopping the

work at the site in Moss-Wright Park and which could result in great cost to the City. The City Manager provided a brief summary of the situation for new commissioner Jim Thomas.

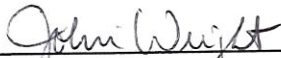
Former commissioner Filson expressed his thanks for all the nice comments and stated that he would continue to serve the City in any way he could help.

The City Manager asked that approval be given for an auction of surplus City property to be held on October 30. Motion by Garrett to approve the auction. Seconded by long. Passed 5-0.

He also asked approval for Tommy Deloach to purchase a laser level transit at a cost of \$1350. Motion by Driver to approve the purchase. Seconded by Thomas. Passed 5-0.

Commissioner Driver asked about the Ponder print of Goodlettsville High School. The City Manager stated that he would find out the cost and would put consideration of the purchase on the agenda for the next meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 7:01 p.m.
