The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Johnny Long.

On a motion by Driver, seconded by Filson, the minutes of the May 9 regular meeting and the May 15 special called meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

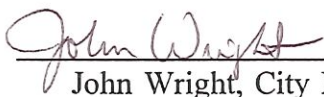
Consider on first reading Ordinance No. 96-536, an ordinance to rezone from R25 to R15 Woodwyn Hills, Section 1, Lots 100, 101, and 102, Sumner County Tax Map 142, part of Parcel 18. The Planning Director explained that the purpose of the rezoning was to allow the reduction in size of the three lots so that the back portions could become part of the common open space and be used for drainage detention. He also stated that the Planning & Zoning Board had recommended the rezoning. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 96-536 on first reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

The Police Chief requested approval for an expenditure of \$25,000 to replace a patrol car and equipment that was totaled in a wreck in March. Motion by Garrett to approve the expenditure of \$25,000 for a new police car and equipment using funds available in the capital expenditures account and police department budget accounts. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

The Mayor welcomed Jack Tompkins, the new City Engineer, to the meeting and to the staff.

The City Manager stated that National Public Works Week was observed by treating the public works department employees to a lunch yesterday. Pam Birdwell, Public Works Department secretary, presented National Public Works Week T-shirts to the commissioners.

The meeting adjourned at 6:42 p.m.
