

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: February 8, 1996

Time: 6:30pm

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Ron Filson.

On a motion by Driver, seconded by Filson, the minutes of the January 11 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

Consider on second reading and public hearing Ordinance No. 95-527, an ordinance to amend certain sections of Title 11 of the Municipal Code, the Goodlettsville Municipal Zoning Ordinance. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Mayor declared the public hearing closed. The City Attorney stated that the wording of the ordinance had been changed to conform to certain wording in the state law and that the Planning and Zoning Board had not yet considered the ordinance in its new form. Motion by Filson to defer consideration on second reading until the Planning and Zoning Board has discussed and made a recommendation on the ordinance. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

The Mayor recognized the members of Cub Scout Pack 200 and Boy Scout Troop 613 who were present.

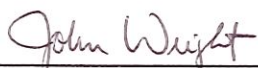
Commissioner Driver passed along a compliment he had received from a resident on Madison Creek Road about prompt chipper service from the Public Works Department.

Commissioner Garrett praised the employees of the Public Works Department who were involved in clearing city streets of snow and ice last week.

Commissioner Long also asked the Public Works Director to pass along to his department's employees that the good work done by them is appreciated.

The City Manager requested approval for an auction of surplus city property on March 30. He also stated that the Mansker Creek Sewer Project will require an archeological study along the proposed route of the sewer line. Bids for the study have been received from Duvall and Associates for \$3500 and from Garrow and Associates for \$4956. Motion by Long to adopt Resolution No. R96-163 to contract with Duvall and Associates for the archeological study. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0. Motion by Garrett to approve the auction of surplus city property on March 30. Seconded by Driver. Passed 5-0.

The meeting adjourned at 6:44 p.m.
