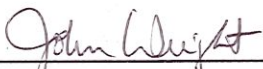

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jerry Garrett.

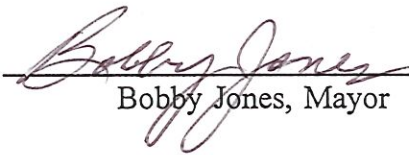
Reconsider Ordinance No. 95-519, an ordinance to acquire property for the Mansker Creek pumping station, as approved on second and final reading on August 10, 1995. Jack Tompkins, Project Manager for Barge, Waggoner, Sumner and Cannon, summarized the Mansker Creek Sewer System Improvements Project and stated the advantages to the City of acquiring the property adjacent to the pump station. A copy of his statement to the Commission is attached to these minutes. Motion by Filson to reconsider on second reading Ordinance No. 95-519. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0. Motion by Garrett to defeat Ordinance No. 95-519 on second reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

Consider on first reading Ordinance No. 95-526, an ordinance to take by condemnation property owned by John M. Hahn, Sr., trustee of John M. Hahn, Sr., Living Trust dated May 1, 1992, for the purpose of acquiring land on which to build the Mansker Creek Sewer System Improvements. Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 95-526 on caption on first reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 5-0.
