

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: September 14, 1995

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Joe Haynes.

On a motion by Filson, seconded by Garrett, the minutes of the August 24 regular meeting and the August 30 special called meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 95-520, an ordinance to amend Title 4, Chapter 4 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code regarding the Standard Building Code. Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 95-520 on second and final reading. Seconded by Filson. Motion by Filson to amend the ordinance to delete duplication of fees. Seconded by Garrett. The motion to amend passed 5-0. The motion to pass the amended ordinance on second reading passed 5-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 95-517, an ordinance to raise the maximum fine for codes violations from \$50 to \$500. The City Attorney stated that he had completed his research on the ordinance. To comply with state law, instead of raising the fine, the ordinance should be imposing a civil penalty. He recommended abandoning Ordinance No. 95-517 and starting over with a new ordinance at the next meeting. A motion by Garrett to defer action on the ordinance was seconded by Filson and then withdrawn. No action was taken on the ordinance.

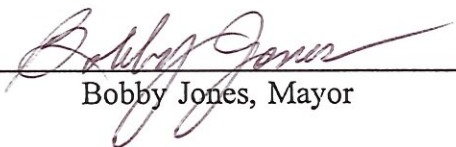
