The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jim Driver.

On a motion by Filson, seconded by Long, the minutes of the June 22 regular meeting and the June 28 special-called meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 95-517, an ordinance to raise the maximum fine for codes violations from \$50 to \$500. The City Manager asked that this item and Ordinance No. 95-519 be deferred. Motion by Garrett to defer action on Ordinances No. 95-517 and 95-519. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 95-518, an ordinance requiring utilities to notify the City and post bond before cutting any city street. The City Attorney pointed out some changes in the original version including provision for allowing cuts without a permit in emergency situations and increasing the amount of the bond and liability insurance amounts. Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 95-518 on second and final reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

Consider resolutions related to the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System. The City Manager asked that the commission consider adopting two resolutions, one to continue the 3.6% indexing of retirement benefits, and the other to allow retirement credit for unused sick leave on retirement. Motion by Driver to adopt Resolution No. R95-148 to continue the 3.6% indexing. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0. Motion by Garrett to adopt Resolution No. R95-149 to authorize retirement credit for unused sick leave. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

Commissioner Long asked the City Attorney to check into the possibility of adding Goodlettsville to the I-65 Exit 98 signs which now refer only to Millersville and Springfield.

The meeting adjourned at 6:53 p.m.
