

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by David Wilson.

On a motion by Driver, seconded by Long, the minutes of the May 25 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

Consider on second reading and public hearing Ordinance No. 95-514, an ordinance to rezone from HDRPUD to ROPUD one parcel at the corner of Dry Creek Lane and Dickerson Road, Davidson County Tax Map 33-4, Parcel 202. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Mayor declared the public hearing closed. Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 95-514 on second reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

Consider on second reading and Ordinance No. 95-513, an ordinance adopting a budget and establishing a property tax rate for the fiscal year July 1, 1995 through June 30, 1996. Motion by Long to defer action since the budget is not complete. Seconded by Filson. Passed 4-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 95-515, an ordinance to amend Section 105-1 of the Standard Unsafe Building Abatement Code by deleting and adding provisions. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 95-515 on second reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 95-516, an ordinance to set up a system of regulating open burning in the City of Goodlettsville. Motion by Filson to defer action until the next meeting to give the City Attorney time to review the ordinance. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

The Mayor asked the City Attorney to check into having an ordinance requiring utilities to notify the City and post bond before cutting City streets.

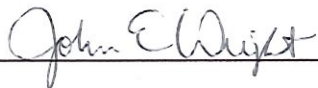
Commissioner Long asked the Public Works Director to have a traffic study done for the intersection at Dickerson Road and Old Springfield Highway.

The City Manager requested that the commission consider adopting a resolution to comply with new requirements for certifying building inspectors. Motion by Filson to adopt Resolution No. R95-147. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

The City Manager stated that the legislature had passed a law allowing cities to raise the maximum fine from \$50 to \$500. He requested that the commission consider passing an ordinance to raise the fines for codes violations. Motion by Driver to pass Ordinance No. 95-517, an ordinance to raise the maximum fine for codes violations from \$50 to \$500, on caption on first reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

The City Manager stated that he had received a letter from a person who had passed through Goodlettsville which complimented the landscaping at City Hall.

The meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
