

MINUTES
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jerry Garrett.

On a motion by Johnny Long, seconded by Jerry Garrett, the minutes of the April 13 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 3-0.

Consider the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Board regarding the request of Robert Shumate to rezone from HDRPUD to ROPUD one parcel at the corner of Dry Creek Lane and Dickerson Road, Davidson County Tax Map 33-4, Parcel 202. Motion by Jerry Garrett to pass on caption on first reading Ordinance No. 95-514 to rezone said parcel from HDRPUD to ROPUD. Seconded by Johnny Long. Passed 3-0.

Consider report from Barge, Waggoner, Sumner & Cannon regarding engineering on the Mansker Creek sewer project. David Wilson asked the board to consider deferral on this item as more information is needed to finalize the report.

Consider a proposal from Mike Chappell & Associates regarding architectural services in connection with the new city fire hall. David Wilson asked the board to consider deferral on this item due to the absence of two commissioners.

Motion by Johnny Long to defer these two items (#3 and #4). Seconded by Jerry Garrett. Passed 3-0.

Commissioner Long expressed his appreciation to the Fire Department for their courageous and professional services this week, referring to the fire and rescue at Fountain View Trailer Park and fatal traffic accidents. David Wilson seconded the comments of Long and commended the Fire Department, also expressing his gratitude that none of our fireman were injured. Mayor Jones also commended the bravery displayed by the firefighters this week.

David Wilson said Parks and Recreation budgeted \$25,000 for playground equipment. The low bid is \$26,800. Mike Alsup described the two units as one for Moss-Wright for ages 2-5, and one for Pleasant Green for all ages. Bids include the equipment, shipping and installation. He said the \$1,800 difference could be transferred from the water account budget. Motion by Jerry Garrett to approve transferring \$1,800 from the water account budget to the Parks capital expense account and to accept the low bid of Murphy Recreation for \$26,800. Seconded by Johnny Long. Approved 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 6.52 p.m.
