

MINUTES OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jim Driver.

Reconsider Ordinances No. 95-507, 95-508, 95-509, and 95-510, ordinances to annex certain territory in Sumner County and to incorporate the same within the corporate boundaries of the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee. The City Manager explained that a resolution to adopt the plan of services for the annexed area should have been passed before the ordinances passed third reading last week. The purpose of reconsidering the ordinances is to provide for adopting the resolution before final passage of the ordinances. Motion by Filson to reconsider Ordinances No. 95-507, 95-508, 95-509, and 95-510. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

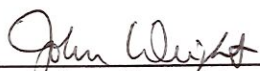
Motion by Long to pass Resolution No. R95-145, a resolution to adopt a plan of service for annexation of various areas in Sumner County and adjacent to the City of Goodlettsville by the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee. Seconded by Filson. Passed 4-0.

Motion by Driver to pass Ordinances No. 95-507, 95-508, 95-509, and 95-510 on third reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

Consider on first reading Ordinance No. 95-512, an ordinance to approve the sale of the Hendersonville property. The City Manager stated that the City Attorney recommends that approval of the sale be done by ordinance prior to the closing. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 95-512 on first reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

With regard to the annexation the City Attorney stated that there is a statutory thirty-day delay before services are to start in the newly annexed areas. Unless the annexation is delayed by an action by the City of Hendersonville, services could begin in thirty days. The City Manager stated that City services in accordance with the plan of service are set to begin thirty days from today.
