The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Johnny Long.

On a motion by Long, seconded by Driver, the minutes of the March 9 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

Consider the Plan of Service for the area proposed for annexation by the City of Goodlettsville. Public Hearing. The Mayor declared the public hearing open. John Bradley, a resident of the proposed area, spoke in opposition to the plan of services and the annexation and asked that the City take no further action in accordance with TCA 6-51-110 since the City of Hendersonville has passed on first reading an ordinance to annex the same area. Dot Maggart spoke in favor of the plan of services and annexation and presented a petition signed by residents of Allen Road requesting that they not be annexed by Hendersonville. The Mayor declared the public hearing closed.

Consider on third reading Ordinance No. 95-507, Ordinance No. 95-508, Ordinance No. 95-509, and Ordinance No. 95-510, ordinances to annex certain territory in Sumner County and to incorporate the same within the corporate boundaries of the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee. Motion by Garrett to pass Ordinance No. 95-507, Ordinance No. 95-508, Ordinance No. 95-509, and Ordinance No. 95-510 on third reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

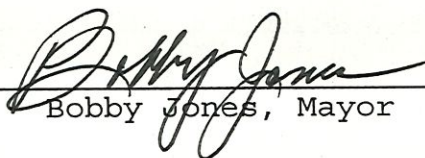
Roger Alley, representing Cub Scout Pack 200, presented a Certificate of Appreciation to the City of Goodlettsville for its support of scouting.
