

MINUTES OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: November 22, 1994

Time: 8:00 a.m.

Place: City Hall

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Ron Filson. *On a motion by Long, Seconded by Garrett, the minutes of the November 10 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.*

Consider on third reading Ordinance No. 94-503, an ordinance to enter into a contract for the replacement of the City Hall roof with Young Sales Company for \$124,363.80, including Alternate 1 for \$3,999.00, making the contract amount \$128,362.80. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 94-503 on third reading. Seconded by Driver. Commissioner Garrett stated that he had received a complaint about the City spending the money for a new roof and wondered if an article should be put in the local newspaper explaining why the roof is being replaced. The City Attorney stated that a press release could be issued to explain the history of the problems with the roof from the beginning and the current lawsuit against the contractor and manufacturer. Tommy Deloach stated that after further discussion with the roofing consultant and contractor the decision has been made to use the specified material in the project. The motion passed 5-0.

Newly re-elected State Representative Tim Garrett stated again his support of the City and pointed out that his district now runs from Rivergate Mall to Bellevue Mall. He suggested that Governor Sundquist be invited to visit Goodlettsville and become familiar with the City. He also stated that his Metro Council District had been reduced in size to become essentially the City of Goodlettsville and that, since term limits are now in effect, his successor as councilman in 1999 should be a strong supporter of the interests of the City.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 a.m.
