The meeting was called to order by Vice-Mayor Long. Prayer was offered by Ron Filson.

On a motion by Filson, seconded by Driver, the minutes of the October 27th regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 94-503, an ordinance to enter into a contract for the replacement of the City Hall roof with Young Sales Company for \$124,363.80, including Alternate 1 for \$3,999.00 making the contract amount \$128,362.80. Motion by Garrett to pass Ordinance No. 94-503 on second reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

The City Manager pointed out that the next meeting falls on Thanksgiving Day and would be cancelled. It was agreed to call a special meeting for 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 22, to consider Ordinance No. 94-503 on third reading.

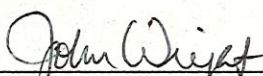
Commissioner Filson asked about questions raised about the material specified in the City Hall reroofing contract. Tommy Deloach stated that he had talked with our roofing consultant, a representative of Young Sales Company, and a salesman for another brand of roofing material about possible problems with the specified brand. The specified brand will be used provided the manufacturer will furnish a letter to guarantee that it will perform as specified.

Commissioner Garrett asked the City Manager to write letters to our newly elected United States Senators and Congressman requesting them to support legislation to remove existing unfunded federal mandates in addition to not imposing any new mandates.

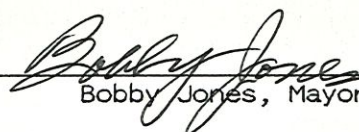
