

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by David Wilson.

City Judge Rob Wheeler administered the oath of office to newly reelected City Commissioners Bobby Jones and Jerry Garrett.

Mayor Jones asked for nominations for Mayor for the next two-year term. Jerry Garrett nominated Bobby Jones. There being no other nominations, Bobby Jones was selected unanimously as Mayor.

The Mayor asked for nominations for Vice-Mayor. Jim Driver nominated Johnny Long. There being no other nominations, Johnny Long was selected unanimously as Vice-Mayor.

On a motion by Driver, seconded by Filson, the minutes of the September 22 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

The Mayor appointed Lee Roy Rice to fill the unexpired term of Jim Lackey on the Industrial Development Board. Motion by Filson to approve the appointment. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

Commissioner Garrett requested that the Public Works Director check on the cleanup of the Metzgar property on Two Mile Pike following recent construction.

Garrett also stated that a citizen had asked about the necessity for the all-way stop at the intersection of Madison Creek and Patton Branch Roads. The Public Works Department will do a traffic count and report back to the commission.

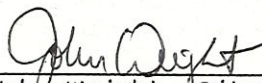
Garrett expressed his concern that only 11 percent of registered voters voted in the recent City election. He suggested an annual report to citizens to inform them about City government in an effort to improve voter participation.

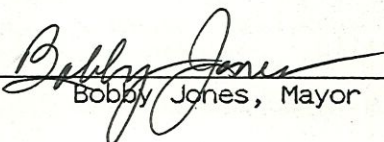
Commissioner Long congratulated Commissioners Jones and Garrett on their reelections.

The City Manager asked the Commission to adopt a resolution to authorize the City to continue its eligibility status in the Federal and State Surplus Property Program. Motion by Filson to adopt Resolution No. R94-142. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

The City Manager also expressed his concern about the low turnout in the City election. He stated that the City could probably benefit from a special census which would increase its portion of state-shared revenue and suggested that information about City government could be distributed during the census.

The meeting adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
