

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: September 22, 1994

Time: 6:30pm

Place: City Hall

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Ron Filson.

On a motion by Driver, seconded by Filson, the minutes of the September 8 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

Andy Dyer spoke on behalf of the Girls Softball League to request that a plaque recognizing the 13-15 year-old World Series Championship team be placed on the quad concession stand. He stated that the Park Board had approved putting a plaque on the building and that the cost of a 24 by 30 inch plaque would be about \$1275. There was no objection to considering the request. Motion by Garrett to purchase a 24 by 30 inch plaque for \$1275 to be placed on the quad concession stand. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

Consider on third reading and public hearing Ordinance No. 94-501, an ordinance to abandon the undeveloped street right-of-way designated as Donna Drive which lies between Lots 20 and 24 on Elba Drive, Page Heights Subdivision, Section 1, Sumner County Tax Map 143-J, Group C, Parcels 34 and 35. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Mayor declared the public hearing closed. The City Manager stated that NES would like to keep a 25 foot utility easement on the property. Motion by Driver to pass Ordinance No. 94-501, including a 25 foot utility easement, on third reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

The Mayor asked about several houses on Emily Drive that do not have sewer available. The Sewer Director stated that there are 11 or 12 lots on Emily Drive and Emily Court that would have required a pump station in order to have sewer service, but the new Beaver Knoll subdivision will have a pump station that can be used to provide service to these lots. The developer will be paying for the pump station, but the City would need to pay for the trunk lines to the Emily Drive area and any upsizing of the pump station necessary to serve those lots.

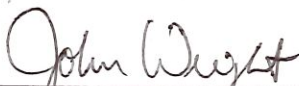
Commissioner Garrett asked if the City Manager had talked with Mr. Thompson of Nashville Gas about extending gas service to McCain Drive. The City Manager stated that he had not been able to talk with him yet but that he was still trying.

Commissioner Driver complimented Tommy Deloach and any others who helped build the new concession stand/restroom buildings for the football and soccer fields.

Commissioner Garrett complimented those responsible for the paving and striping at Pleasant Green Pool.

The City Manager stated that the persons working on the John Ross Memorial would like a commitment from the City this week if possible. There was no objection to considering the request for a contribution. Commissioner Long stated that he knows first-hand of the many years John Ross served without pay to assist with training of the Goodlettsville Police Department. Motion by Long to donate \$2000 to the John Ross Memorial Fund. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

The meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
