

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: August 25, 1994

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jim Driver.

On a motion by Long, seconded by Filson, the minutes of the August 11 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

Consider on third reading and public hearing Ordinance No. 94-500, an ordinance to amend Title 11, the official zoning map of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Ordinance No. 89-413 (as amended) by changing the zoning classification of certain property from LDRPUD to HDRPUD. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Mayor declared the public hearing closed. In answer to a question from the audience the City Manager stated that Highland Heights Drive would not be extended to Dickerson Road. Motion by Driver to pass Ordinance No. 94-500 on third reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

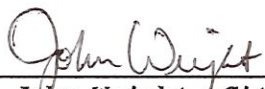
Consider a request from Dixie Youth Baseball and Dixie Girls Softball for a donation from the General Fund to help with the expenses of teams going to World Series Tournaments. The City Manager stated that three boys teams and two girls teams had gone to the World Series but that the leagues had not yet requested a specific amount from the City. Motion by Filson to defer action until the amount is known. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

Consider a request from the Bowen-Campbell Association for matching funds in connection with their application for a Federal Historic Preservation Grant. The City Manager stated that the purpose of the grant is for further archeological excavation around the Bowen House. If the grant is approved the City's portion would be \$5,000. Motion by Long to donate \$5000 to the Bowen-Campbell Association if the grant application is approved. Seconded by Filson. Passed 4-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 94-502, an ordinance to approve a contract with the State Department of Transportation for the construction of sidewalks on Long Hollow Pike from I-65 to Dickerson Road. The City Manager stated that the City Attorney had reviewed and approved the contract. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 94-502 on second reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

The City Manager asked the commission to consider at a future meeting a donation toward the Metro Police Academy memorial for Assistant Police Chief John Ross.

The meeting adjourned at 6:44 p.m.
