

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jerry Garrett.

On a motion by Driver, seconded by Long, the minutes of the May 26 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 94-495, an ordinance of the City of Goodlettsville adopting a budget and establishing a property tax rate for the fiscal year July 1, 1994, through June 30, 1995. Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 94-495 on second reading, setting the tax rate at \$0.22 per \$100 for both counties. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

Consider on second reading Ordinance No. 94-496, an ordinance to provide for a late fee for sewer payments not received within 15 days of the due date. Motion by Garrett to pass Ordinance No. 94-496 on second reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

Motion by Driver to adopt Resolution No. R94-139, to request the Madison Suburban Utility District to change the refundable deposit for new sewer customers to a non-refundable connection fee. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

Consider on first reading Ordinance No. 94-497, an ordinance to direct the Davidson County Election Commission to call an election to fill the terms of two (2) Commissioners of the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee, pursuant to T.C.A. Section 6-20-105. Motion by Garrett to pass Ordinance No. 94-497 on first reading and set the election date as the first Tuesday in October. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

Discuss purchase of property at corner of Memorial Drive and French Street, Davidson County Tax Map 25-4, Parcel 110. Motion by Long not to proceed with the purchase of the property at this time. Seconded by Driver. Passed 4-0.

Consider appointments of one member to the Planning & Zoning Board and one member to the Industrial Development Board. The Mayor appointed Jim Thomas to the Planning & Zoning Board and deferred the other appointment to the next meeting. Motion by Garrett to approve the appointment of Jim Thomas. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

The Mayor asked about the Two Mile Pike sewer project. The Sewer Director stated that the pump had been ordered and that the contractor is ready to start when the pump arrives in a few weeks.

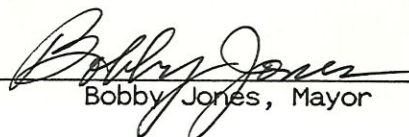
The City Manager reminded the Commission about the Volunteer Firemen's Banquet set for June 25 at 6:00 p.m.
