

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Vice-Mayor Long. Prayer was offered by David Wilson.

On a motion by Driver, seconded by Garrett, the minutes of the January 27 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 3-0.

Ordinance No. 93-490, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 93-477, the budget for fiscal year July 1, 1993, through June 30, 1994, by increasing the appropriation for the Solid Waste Fund to \$410,000, increasing interfund transfers to \$702,500, and increasing the total budget to \$8,611,050. Public hearing and third reading. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Vice-Mayor declared the public hearing closed. Motion by Driver to pass Ordinance No. 93-490 on third reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 3-0.

Consider the recommendation of the Planning & Zoning Board to rezone from CPUD to HDRPUD property located within Northcreek Commons, being Davidson County Tax Map 26, Parcels 72 and 119, for development of Northcreek Commons Apartment Complex (428 units). (Ordinance No. 94-491) Motion by Driver to pass Ordinance No. 94-491 on first reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 3-0.

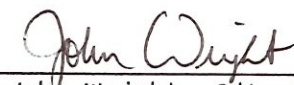
Consider a resolution in opposition to certain bills being considered by the State Legislature. Motion by Garrett to adopt Resolution No. R94-137, a resolution to oppose any state legislation which dictates or mandates municipal personnel policy, particularly in the areas of employee recognition, collective bargaining, mediation, and binding arbitration. Seconded by Driver. Passed 3-0.

Consider transfer of funds for capital projects approved at mid-year budget session. Deferred to the next meeting.

Motion by Commissioner Garrett that the City donate \$2500 to the Goodlettsville Help Center since it is running low on funds. Seconded by Driver. Passed 3-0.

The City Manager and Vice-Mayor commended City employees for their good work during and after the recent ice storm.

The meeting adjourned at 6:48 p.m.
