

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jerry Garrett.

On a motion by Filson, seconded by Garrett, the minutes of the October 28 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 4-0.

Ordinance No. 93-489, an ordinance to dissolve the Historical & Arts Council and rescind Ordinance No. 86-339, as amended. Second reading. Motion by Garrett to pass on second reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

Consider a resolution to amend the City Personnel Policies & Procedures Manual to comply with the Family & Medical Leave Act of 1993 and to reflect changes in employee longevity pay and Deferred Compensation Plan. Motion by Filson to adopt Resolution No. R93-134, change 4 to the Personnel Policies & Procedures Manual. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 4-0.

Commissioner Filson complimented the City employees installing the new street lights at Moss-Wright Park.

Commissioner Garrett stated that he had received several complaints that the Christmas lights on Main Street were put up too early. It was agreed that they should not be installed until after Thanksgiving next year.

Commissioner Long suggested that plaques be presented to the three men who rescued the woman who was attacked and robbed at Rivergate Mall recently and that a program be set up to recognize any citizen who helps the police department to prevent or solve a crime.

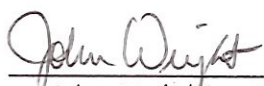
The City Manager stated that he and the Police Chief had discussed conducting self-defense seminars at City Hall.

Commissioner Filson suggested that the police department could give firearms training to citizens at the firing range.

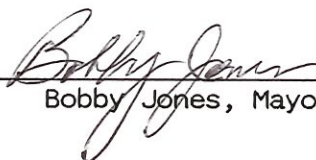
Tommy Deloach reported that the Chamber of Commerce Beautification Committee will be giving a \$250 gift certificate for the best residential Christmas decorations this year.
