

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Johnny Long.

On a motion by Long, seconded by Garrett, the minutes of the August 26 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

Ordinance No. 93-484, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No 87-387, as amended, Title 7, Chapter 5, Sections 7-501, 7-513, and 7-519 of the Municipal Code regarding the Burglary and Robbery Alarm Ordinance. Third reading. Motion by Driver to pass on third reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 93-485, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 89-419, as amended by Ordinance No. 92-456, Title 9 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Chapter 5, Section 9-505, "Parking for the Handicapped" to increase the fine from \$50 to \$100. Third reading. Motion by Long to pass on third reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 93-486, an ordinance to amend Title 2, Chapter 2 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code regarding the sale of beer, to comply with 1993 Public Acts, Chapter 297, which amends TCA Title 57, Chapter 4, Part 1. Second reading. Motion by Garrett to pass on second reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 93-481, an ordinance to abandon a sewer easement on Church Street. Second reading. Motion by Driver to pass on second reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

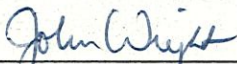
Consider entering into negotiations with Goodlettsville Masonic Lodge for a land swap in order to construct a new fire hall. Motion by Garrett for the commission to authorize the Mayor and City Manager to enter into negotiations with the Masonic Lodge for a land swap to expedite the construction of a new fire hall. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

The Mayor appointed Walter Slater to fill the vacancy on the Beer Board.

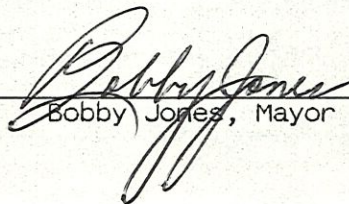
Commissioner Long requested that the staff take steps to have a left turn signal added to the traffic light for vehicles coming out of Bluebird Drive at Two Mile Parkway.
