

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jim Driver.

On a motion by Filson, seconded by Long, the minutes of the May 27 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

Ordinance No. 93-476, an ordinance to amend Zoning Ordinance No. 89-413, as amended, Title 11, Chapter 9, Section 11-901(n) and 11-901(q) of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, by adding or changing various provisions relating to yard sales, fireworks sales, flea markets, farmers' markets, and similar temporary uses. Second reading. The Planning Director summarized the changes recommended by the Planning & Zoning Board which discussed the ordinance at its last meeting. Motion by Driver to pass on second reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

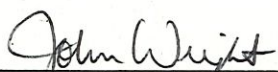
Ordinance No. 93-479, an ordinance to amend Title 8, Chapter 3, Section 8-308, of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, by adding or changing various provisions relating to abatement of conditions of excessive weeds, grass, litter, and other conditions. Third reading. Motion by Long to pass on third reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 93-480, an ordinance to amend Title 5, Chapter 2, of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code by adding or changing various provisions relating to peddlers, solicitors, and transient merchants. Second reading. Motion by Driver to defer since the Planning & Zoning Board had not yet discussed this ordinance. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

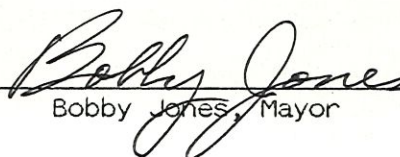
Consider abandonment of a sewer easement at 305 Church Street. The City Manager pointed out that this item needs to be considered by the Planning & Zoning Board but that an ordinance could be passed on caption on first reading in order to start the process to remove the easement from the Miller Litho property on Church Street. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 93-481 on caption on first reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

Commissioner Long asked about the property at the corner of Depot and Main Street. It still appears to be operating as a salvage yard. The Planning Director stated that the property is on notice to stop the salvage business and that he would check into the situation.
