

MINUTES OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jim Driver.

Ordinance No. 93-474, an ordinance to enter into a contract with the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation for construction of sidewalks on the north and south sides of Long Hollow Pike from near I-65 to Mansker Creek, Project Number STP-M-174(7). Third reading. Motion by Long to pass on third reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 93-475, an ordinance to consider the recommendation of the Planning & Zoning Board to rezone Parcel 162, Davidson County Tax Map 25, part of the Ruth Sisco Subdivision, from Agricultural to R-25. Second reading. Motion by Driver to pass on second reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

Consider approval of capital expenditure for Mansker Station repairs. The City Manager stated that approval of \$25,000 should be enough for this fiscal year and allow the project to get started. Motion by Filson to approve the expenditure of \$25,000 for the repair of Mansker Station. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

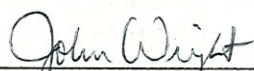
Consider action regarding proposals for engineering in connection with the Mansker Creek sewer trunk line project. The City Manager explained that proposals for the engineering of the project were requested from three firms: Barge, Waggoner, Sumner and Cannon; Ragan-Smith Associates; and Gresham-Smith and Partners. Interviews have been held and cost estimates for the four phases of the project have been received, with the lowest prices coming from Barge, Waggoner, Sumner and Cannon. Motion by Garrett to award the engineering for the Mansker Creek sewer trunk line project to Barge, Waggoner, Sumner and Cannon subject to executing a proper contract with that firm. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

Commissioner Driver asked about a spring cleanup for the City. The City Manager said that he would contact the Chamber of Commerce Beautification Committee about setting a date.

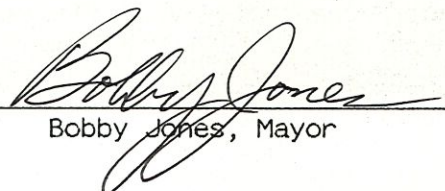
Commissioner Filson stated that the City needs to enforce our litter ordinance. The Public Works Department is having to spend a lot of its time picking up litter along the roads in the City.
