

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: March 25, 1993

Time: 6:30pm

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Jerry Garrett.

On a motion by Long, seconded by Filson, the minutes of the March 11 regular meeting were approved as written by a vote of 5-0.

Consider a request from John Cannon on behalf of G. F. Puhl Company to rezone their property located at 675 N. Dickerson Road from CS (Commercial Services) to IG (Industrial General). Mr. Cannon tonight asked that the property be rezoned to IR (Industrial Restricted) since the Planning & Zoning Board had twice denied requests to rezone to IG (Industrial General). Motion by Filson to defer action until the next meeting to give time for the Commission to get information from the Planning Director about the two types of industrial zoning. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 93-473, an ordinance authorizing the City of Goodlettsville to abandon a portion of a 25-foot common ingress/egress easement between Lot 3 (Parcel 136) and Lot 4 (Parcel 137) of Northgate Park, Section 12, Davidson County Tax Map 26-1. Second reading. Motion by Driver to pass on second reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

Consider an ordinance to enter into a contract with the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation for construction of sidewalks on the north and south sides of Long Hollow Pike from near I-65 to Mansker Creek, Project Number STP-M-174(7). (Ordinance No. 93-474) The City Manager explained that this project will be done as part of the project to widen Long Hollow Pike, which includes sidewalks from Mansker Creek to the city limit. No City expenditure will be required since the project is funded by State and Federal funds. Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 93-474 on first reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 5-0.

Consider a resolution authorizing MTAS (Municipal Technical Advisory Service) to recodify our Municipal Code. MTAS recommends this be done every ten years. Motion by Filson to pass Resolution No. R93-127. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

Commissioner Garrett pointed out that the April 22 Commission meeting will conflict with the Chamber of Commerce Banquet at the Community Center and will need to be cancelled or rescheduled.

The meeting adjourned at 6:49 pm.
