

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: November 12, 1992

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Johnny Long.

Motion by Long to approve the minutes of the October 22 regular meeting. Seconded by Filson and passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 92-468, an ordinance to establish a comprehensive infectious disease-control policy for the City of Goodlettsville in compliance with rules and regulations established by the U. S. Department of Labor. Third reading. Motion by Filson to pass on third reading. Seconded by Driver. Passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 92-469, an ordinance to rezone Parcels 128 and 130, Sumner County Tax Map 121, from A (Agricultural) to R-40 (Low Density Residential). Second reading. Commissioner Long asked if a public hearing was required on this ordinance. The City Manager stated that the public hearing would be held on third reading. Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 92-469 on second reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

Hear report from the Park Director on policies and procedures for a senior day care center. The Park Director presented the proposed guidelines for operation of the center for the rest of this fiscal year. The center would start January 5th, be open Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday at first, and expand to every day if successful. A maximum of \$33,700 would be required to prepare the room and operate for six months. Motion by Filson to authorize the expenditure of up to \$35,000 this fiscal year to initiate the senior day care program. Seconded by Driver. Passed 5-0.

Consider a resolution to join the Metropolitan Nashville/Davidson County Solid Waste Planning Region. Motion by Driver to adopt Resolution No. R92-122. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

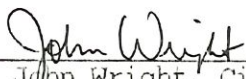
Consider appointment to the Solid Waste Planning Region Board. Motion by Long to appoint Public Works Director Bill Brasier to the regional solid waste planning board. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

Commissioner Long asked about the status of the sidewalk program. The Planning Director stated that approval is expected by the end of the year for the plan to extend sidewalks on Long Hollow Pike in conjunction with the project to widen Long Hollow Pike to four lanes out to Madison Creek Road.

The City Manager pointed out that the next scheduled commission meeting is Thanksgiving Day. Motion by Garrett to cancel the November 26th regular meeting. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

The Mayor congratulated City Attorney Joe Haynes on his reelection to the State Senate. The City Manager pointed out that former Goodlettsvillian Don Wright was also elected to the State Senate and will represent the citizens of the City who live in Sumner County.

The meeting adjourned at 6:54 pm.
