

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jones. Prayer was offered by Joe Haynes.

Motion by Filson to approve the minutes of the October 8 regular meeting. Seconded by Long and passed 5-0.

Mayor Jones read and presented to Derek Owen a proclamation honoring Derek for his heroism in rescuing a two-year old girl who had jumped into a swimming pool without a flotation device. State Senator Joe Haynes also presented to Derek a certificate appointing him as an honorary member of Senator Haynes' staff.

Park Director Mike Alsup and Commissioner Garrett presented plaques to the four state championship baseball and softball teams: ASA Class B Angels (10 years old and under), Dixie Softball Ponytails (12 years old and under), Dixie Youth Baseball (13 years old), and Dixie Youth Baseball Pre-Majors (15 and 16 years old).

Ordinance No. 92-468, an ordinance to establish a comprehensive infectious disease-control policy for the City of Goodlettsville in compliance with rules and regulations established by the U. S. Department of Labor. Second reading. Motion by Driver to pass on second reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

Consider the recommendation of the Planning & Zoning Board to rezone Parcels 128 and 130, Sumner County Tax Map 121, from A (Agricultural) to R-40 (Low Density Residential). (Ordinance No. 92-469) Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 92-469 on first reading. Seconded by Garrett. Passed 5-0.

Consider funding to develop policies and procedures for a senior day care center. The Park Director requested the appropriation of \$1000 to hire Betty Walker to assist in the writing of policies and procedures for the program. He also stated that the program could begin in January at the Community Center and would cost about \$36,400 this fiscal year. Motion by Garrett to appropriate \$1000 to develop the policies and procedures. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

Commissioner Garrett asked that the Commission consider designating a City Historian to preserve the City's history and establish a City archives.

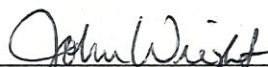
The Park Director presented a recommendation from the Mansker Foundation that the Board of Directors of the Foundation be appointed to a City Tourism Board to

function like the Park Board and advise the commission on tourism-related activities, programs, and expenditures.

The City Manager announced that he and Commissioner Garrett had a granddaughter born this afternoon.

He also stated that the Blue Cross Wellness Screening had caused much comment and interest among City employees and that he would present to the commission a proposal for an incentive program to encourage employees to take steps to improve their health.
