The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Jim Denton. Motion by Long to approve the minutes of the August 27 regular meeting. Seconded by Jones and passed 4-0.

Ordinance No. 92-466, an ordinance to approve a contract with the State to reimburse the City up to \$6,000 for the cost of the City Planner's participation in the Metropolitan Planning Organization. Third reading. Motion by Jones to pass Ordinance No. 92-466 on third reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 4-0.

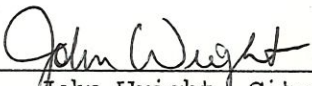
Ordinance No. 92-467, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 67-79, as amended, by deleting the entire Chapter 11, "Board of Parks and Recreation" of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Title I (as amended by Ordinance No. 90-433), and inserting a new Chapter 11. Second reading. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 92-467 on second reading. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

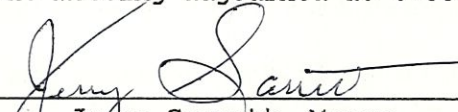
The Mayor deferred consideration of amendments to the Personnel Policies & Procedures Manual to the next meeting.

Commissioner Filson responded to a letter from the Park Director by stating that action needs to be taken as soon as possible to establish an adult day care program at the Community Center.

Virginia Pemerton, who resides at 2020 Willis Branch Road, presented a petition signed by the residents of Willis Branch Road which requests that they be annexed into the City. The Mayor stated that the request will be passed to the Planning & Zoning Board for study and recommendation to the commission.
