

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: July 23, 1992

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Allen Dorris. Motion by Long to approve the minutes of the July 9 regular meeting. Seconded by Jones and passed 5-0.

The Mayor presented a check for \$3000 to Regina Toole and other representatives of the Gateway Elementary PTA. The donation is for the purchase of playground equipment for the school.

Consider recommendation of the Planning & Zoning Board to accept by resolution and abandon by ordinance the right-of-way of the remaining portion of Central Avenue, north of Dickerson Road. Motion by Driver to pass Ordinance No. 92-463 on first reading. Seconded by Long. The Planning Director explained that the property owner had been using the right-of-way as a driveway and parking lot for many years and had requested that the ROW be abandoned since the remainder of the ROW had been previously abandoned. Ordinance No. 92-463 passed first reading on a vote of 5-0.

Consider the recommendation of the Planning & Zoning Board to annex Parcels 128 and 130, Sumner County Tax Map 121, into the City. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance 92-464 on first reading. Seconded by Jones. Passed 5-0.

Consider the recommendation of the Planning & Zoning Board to study a request based upon a petition for the annexation of Hogan Branch Road. The Planning Director stated that he and the Assistant Fire Chief had begun a preliminary study. The commissioners asked several questions about the roads, fire hydrants, and number of homes in the area. Sonny Ponder, a member of the Planning & Zoning Board and resident of Hogan Branch, spoke for the residents who had signed the petition. Motion by Driver to complete the study of the area. Seconded by Filson. Commissioner Long asked about the possibility of including the referendum for annexation on the ballot for the regular city election on October 1. The motion passed 5-0.

The Mayor appointed Gary Webster to the Planning & Zoning Board to serve the unexpired term of Jim Driver.

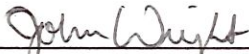
The Mayor asked how often the chipper service is running. The Public Works Director stated that the truck had been out of service and they are running about a week behind schedule.

The City Manager requested that the commission pass on first reading an ordinance to approve a contract with the State to reimburse the City for the relocation of

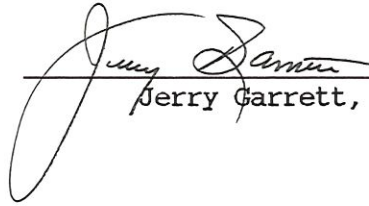
sewer lines required by the widening of Long Hollow Pike. Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 92-465 on caption on first reading. Seconded by Jones. Passed 5-0.

Commissioner Jones asked about the status of the ordinance regulating the emptying of dumpsters. The City Manager stated that the City Attorney was unable to attend tonight's meeting but had said that the revised ordinance would be ready for the next meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 7:02 p.m.
