

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Rev. Ken Edwards of Connell Memorial United Methodist Church. Motion by Filson to approve the minutes of the June 25 regular meeting and the June 30 special called meeting. Seconded by Long and passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 92-457, an ordinance to abandon a 50-foot right-of-way on Draper Drive between Parcels 28 and 29, Davidson County Tax Map 33-4. Third reading. Motion by Driver to pass on third reading. Seconded by Jones. Passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 92-461, an ordinance to direct the Davidson County Election Commission to call an election to fill the terms of three (3) Commissioners of the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee, pursuant to T.C.A. Section 6-20-105. Third reading. Motion by Jones to pass Ordinance No. 92-461 on third reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

Ordinance No. 92-462, an ordinance to amend Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Title 8 (Health & Sanitation), Chapter 2 (Refuse), by adding a new Section (8-215) to regulate the hours for emptying or removing containers used for the accumulation or handling of garbage or rubbish when said containers are located near buildings or structures used for residential purposes. Second reading. The City Attorney requested that second reading be deferred until the ordinance could be rewritten to include a penalty clause, which would require that a public hearing be held.

An appointment to the vacancy on the Planning & Zoning Board was deferred to the next regular meeting.

Vice-Mayor Jones thanked all the city departments and employees for their work in making the July 4th celebration a success.

Commissioner Long asked about the status of the damaged road into Northcreek Commons. The City Attorney stated that the lawsuit would be filed next week.

Long also asked about the repair of Long Hollow Pike at the Bank. The Public Works Director said that it should be finished tomorrow.

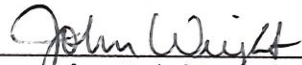
Filson asked if Madison Utility was finished with the project on Shevel Drive. The Public Works Director said that they had quite a bit of work yet to do.

Commissioner Long asked that the Goodwill trailers at Kroger be cleaned up. The City Manager will look into the situation.

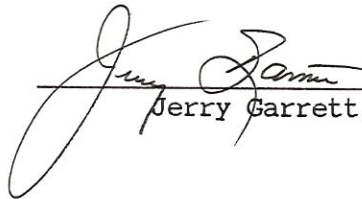
