

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: April 9, 1992

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Mike Alsup. Motion by Long to approve the minutes of the March 26 regular meeting. Seconded by Jones and passed 5-0.

Park Director Mike Alsup requested the approval of a capital expenditure of \$1400 for the purchase of a safety air pack to be used by persons changing chlorine tanks at the swimming pool. Motion by Jones to approve the request. Seconded by Filson. Passed 5-0.

Assistant Fire Chief Phillip Gibson requested the approval of capital expenditures of \$2100 to replace a twelve-year-old ice machine and \$1518 to buy Firesoft software for the fire department computer. Motion by Long to approve the request and a transfer from the supply account if necessary to keep the capital expenditures account from exceeding the budgeted amount. Seconded by Jones. Passed 5-0.

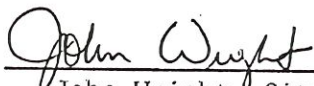
Commissioner Childers asked that a date be set for the Fire Department Banquet. It was decided to hold the banquet on May 9.

Commissioner Filson moved that the City Planner and City Manager be directed to take any actions necessary to have the property at 124 Draper Drive cleaned up as soon as possible. Seconded by Long. Passed 5-0.

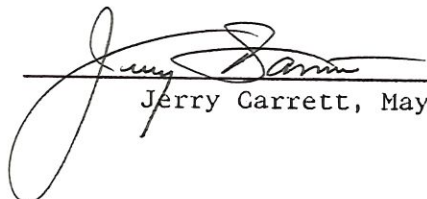
