

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Terry Simmons. Motion by Long to approve the minutes of the February 27 regular meeting. Seconded by Childers and passed 4-0.

Ordinance No. 92-455, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 89-419 by adding a new chapter to Title 9 "Motor Vehicles and Traffic" of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, being Chapter 7, to establish additional traffic regulations. Third reading. Motion by Long to pass on third reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 4-0.

Ordinance No. 92-456, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 89-419 by amending Title 9 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Chapter 5, Section 9-505 "Handicap Parking" to increase the fine from \$25.00 to \$50.00. Third reading. Motion by Childers to pass on third reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed 4-0.

The Mayor appointed Jim Hitt and Joe Birdwell to the Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals.

Hear Paul Finholt, owner of Mason's Motel, with regard to the hotel/motel tax. Deferred to the next meeting at the request of Mr. Finholt.

Consider the recommendation of the Planning & Zoning Board to abandon a 50' right-of-way on Draper Drive between Parcels 28 and 29, Davidson County Tax Map 33-4. (Ordinance No. 92-457) Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 92-457 on caption on first reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed 4-0.

Consider the request of the Bicentennial Committee to spend \$3500 of its \$7000 budget to purchase a special 5'x7' print of the official Tennessee Bicentennial painting "The Pride of Tennessee." Pam Garrett introduced Mike Vaughn, coordinator of the state's Bicentennial Celebration activities, who displayed and described a small print of the painting. He explained that only one large print will be displayed in each county, and if the City buys a copy, it will be the only one in Davidson County. The Mayor stated that the Commission will take the request under advisement and give an answer as soon as possible.

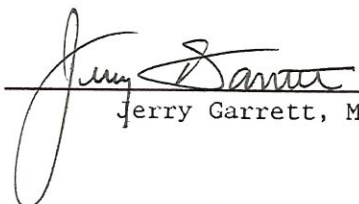
Consider a resolution to approve the sale of certain surplus City property. Motion by Filson to adopt Resolution No. R92-119. Seconded by Long. Passed 4-0.

The City Manager thanked Pam and Tim Garrett for hosting lunch for a delegation of twenty citizens and officials from Clarksville who came to Goodlettsville to see Mansker Station and discuss how it was done. He also stated that one official complimented the City on the positive effect of our sign ordinance.
