The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Johnny Long. Motion by Jones to approve the minutes of the February 13 regular meeting. Seconded by Filson and passed unanimously.

Park Commissioner Ron Filson and Park Director Mike Alsup presented plaques to the players and coaches on the four local teams that won state championships last summer: age 10 and under Girls Softball, age 16-19 Girls Softball, age 13 Dixie Boys Baseball, and age 15-16 Dixie Pre-Majors Baseball.

Ordinance No. 92-455, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 89-419 by adding a new chapter to Title 9 "Motor Vehicles and Traffic" of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, being Chapter 7, to establish additional traffic regulations. Second reading. Motion by Filson to pass on second reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 92-456, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 89-419 by amending Title 9 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Chapter 5, Section 9-505 "Handicap Parking" to increase the fine from \$25.00 to \$50.00. Second reading. Motion by Jones to pass on second reading. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously.

The Mayor appointed Jeff Cordell to the vacancy on the Park Board and re-appointed the following persons whose terms had expired at the end of 1991: Roy Duncan to the Beer Board; Dick Renfro to the Park Board; Oscar Brooks, Olin Jones, John Tyler, and Leona Moyers to the Industrial Development Board; Gary Borhart to the Goodlettsville Hearing Authority; Walter Ponder, Billy Hitt, and Bobbie Wilson to the Planning & Zoning Board; and Eddie Niebruegge to the Board of Zoning Appeals. He deferred appointments to the Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals to the next meeting.

Consider renaming the Dry Creek extension road from Dickerson Road to Alta Loma. The City Manager explained that the Post Office has requested that the road be renamed so that numbers can be assigned when homes or businesses are located on the road. No numbers are available now since the existing Dry Creek Road begins numbering with 100. Motion by Long to refer the matter to the Planning & Zoning Board for study and recommendation. Seconded by Filson. Passed unanimously.

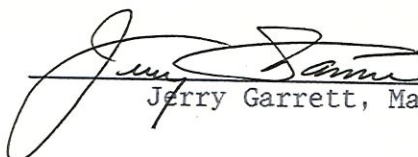
The Mayor informed the commissioners that the Goodlettsville Motel Association has requested to be on the agenda for the next meeting to discuss the motel tax.
