

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

Date: February 13, 1992

Time: 6:30pm

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Bobby Jones. Motion by Filson to approve the minutes of the January 23 regular meeting. Seconded by Long and passed unanimously.

Hear report from Codes Director and Police Chief regarding inadequacy of handicap parking provided in certain areas of the City. The Police Chief reported that numerous citations were given for illegal use of handicap parking spaces during 1991 but that enforcement can be stepped up. He also recommended that the fine for that offense be increased from \$25 to \$50. The Planning Director reported that he had studied the handicap parking in the Rivergate Mall and Plaza parking areas. Of the total of 5400 parking spaces, 42 are handicap spaces, but not all of the entrances into the mall have handicap spaces near the door. Current standards would call for 64 handicap spaces, but since the mall was built before those standards went into effect, the mall cannot be required to add more spaces. The Mayor requested that the Planning Director discuss with the mall management the possibility of increasing the number and improving the location of the handicap spaces. He also asked the City Manager to write a letter to Jim and Mary Binkley to let them know the results of the study and the City's plan of action.

Consider an amendment to Ordinance No. 89-419 by amending Title 9 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Chapter 5, Section 9-505 "Handicap Parking" to increase the \$25.00 fine. Motion by Filson to increase the fine for illegally parking in a handicap parking space from \$25 to \$50. Seconded by Childers. Ordinance No. 92-456 passed unanimously on caption on first reading.

Consider an amendment to Ordinance No. 89-419 to add a new chapter to Title 9 "Motor Vehicles and Traffic" of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, being Chapter 7, to establish additional traffic regulations. The Police Chief explained that the purpose of the ordinance was to add certain State offenses to the City code so violators can be cited to City Court. Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 92-455 on first reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed unanimously.

The Mayor asked that appointments to vacancies on two City boards be deferred to the next meeting. The City Manager pointed out that several board members whose terms expired at the end of 1991 need to be reappointed.

Motion by Commissioner Long to pass a resolution to inform the Sumner County School Board that the City of Goodlettsville opposes any rezoning that would send elementary students living in the Sumner County part of the City to any school other than Beech Elementary. Seconded by Filson. Resolution No. R92-118 passed unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 6:53pm.
