

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Lloyd Gragg. Minutes of the August 8 regular meeting were approved as written.

Ordinance No. 91-449, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 90-438, Goodlettsville Municipal Code, Title 1, Chapter 1, Section 1-101, to provide that the regular meeting date for the Goodlettsville City Commission shall remain on the second and fourth Thursday of each month. Third reading. Motion by Filson to pass on third reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

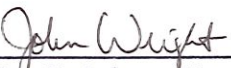
Ordinance No. 91-450, an ordinance to replace in its entirety Sign Ordinance No. 87-386, Title 14, Chapter 1, of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code, to regulate the use, location, type, number, construction, maintenance, and size of all signs; to provide for amortization of non-conforming signs; to provide for a permit, fee, and enforcement system; and to provide for appeals and variances with limitations. First reading. Motion by Jones to pass on first reading. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously.

Commissioner Long requested a follow-up on the possible removal of the merging lane at I-65 on Two Mile Parkway.

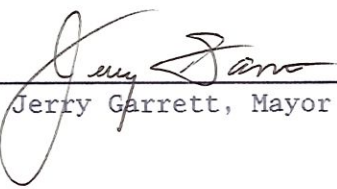
Commissioner Childers stated that action needs to be taken to remove the old truck next to Swift Stop Market and the house parked on the vacant lot at Caldwell and Long Hollow Pike. Violation letters have been sent and citations will be issued if the truck and house are not moved by the deadline.

Mayor Garrett suggested that the Goodlettsville High School composite class photos be hung on the walls at the Community Center and that the GHS trophies be displayed in cases at the Community Center. It was agreed that this should be done if space permits.
