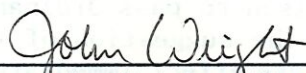

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett.

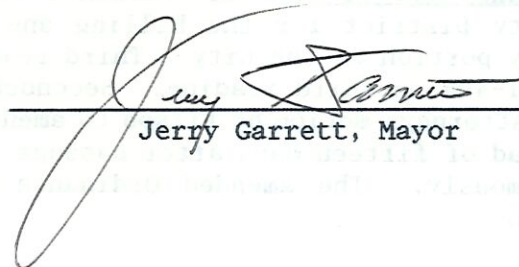
Consider proposals for renovation of the Bowen-Campbell House and waiver of the advertisement for sealed bid process. The City Attorney's opinion is that a waiver of the sealed bid process is legal in this situation. Maintenance Superintendent Tommy DeLoach reported that the proposal of Leatherwood, Inc. should cover any unforeseen expenses and require no change orders. Motion by Jones to waive the sealed bid process and award the contract to renovate the Bowen-Campbell House to Leatherwood, Inc. for \$36,374. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Consider adoption of two resolutions recommended by the Tennessee Municipal League regarding Community Development Block Grants and Anti-Drug Funds. Motion by Childers to adopt Resolution No. R91-114 regarding Anti-Drug Funds. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously. Resolution regarding Community Development Block Grants failed for lack of a motion.
