The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Ron Filson. Minutes of the January 24 meeting were approved as written.

Ordinance No. 90-441, an ordinance to establish \$2500 as the minimum amount of purchase for which sealed bids must be taken. Third reading. Motion by Long to pass on third reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Appointments to the Hearing Authority and Industrial Development Board were deferred to the next meeting.

Consider a resolution allowing Commissioners to participate in the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System. Motion by Filson to pass Resolution No. R91-113. Seconded by Jones. Passed unanimously.

Consider an ordinance to amend the Sewer Use Ordinance No. 82-283, Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 13, Chapter 2, Sections 13-201, 13-203, and 13-204. (Ordinance No. 91-442). Motion by Jones to pass Ordinance No. 91-442 on first reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed unanimously.

Consider an ordinance to amend the Standard Building Code Ordinance No. 86-348, as amended, Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 4, Chapter 4, by adding various provisions. (Ordinance No. 91-443). Motion by Long to pass Ordinance No. 91-443 on first reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed unanimously.

Consider request from Goodlettsville Area Chamber of Commerce to present an annual award to a City employee in recognition of outstanding contribution to the community. Motion by Jones to approve the request. Seconded by Filson. Passed unanimously.

Consider appointment of a committee to study establishment of a foundation for operation and oversight of Historic Mansker's Station. Motion by Filson to approve the study and authorize the Mayor to appoint a committee. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Consider approval of amendments to park rules as recommended by the Park Board. Motion by Jones to approve the amendments. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously.

Consider an ordinance to enter into a contract with White House Utility District for the billing and collection of sewer fees in the Sumner County portion of the City. (Ordinance No. 91-444). Motion by Filson to pass Ordinance No. 91-444 on caption on first reading. Seconded by Jones. Passed unanimously.

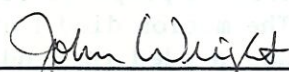
Motion by Filson to approve an agreement with the Fulton Governmental Group to act as lobbyist for the City with the State Legislature. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously.

Motion by Filson to amend the sign ordinance with regard to Interstate Sign District and other areas after study by the Planning & Zoning Board. Seconded by Long. Ordinance No. 91-445 passed unanimously on caption on first reading.

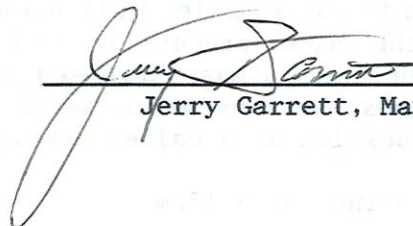
Motion by Filson that City vehicles display the American flag in support of our troops in the Persian Gulf War and that a marker be placed in Gazebo Park listing the residents of Goodlettsville who serve in that war. Seconded by Jones. Passed unanimously.

The City Manager asked Senator Haynes to study the possibility of introducing legislation to change requirements for holding uncontested elections. The cost of the most recent City election was over \$7400. The Senator stated that he would look into the problem and report back to the commission.
