MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
GOODLETTSVILLE CITY COMMISSION

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Bobby Jones. Minutes of the December 13 meeting were approved as written.

Ordinance No. 90-439, an ordinance to amend Title 14, Chapter 1 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code (Sign Ordinance No. 87-386), Sections 14-103 3.1(i), 14-103 3.5(a), 14-105 5.1(e)(3), and 14-107 7.2, by deleting some provisions and adding other provisions. Second reading and public hearing. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance, and the Mayor declared the public hearing closed. Motion by Long to pass on second reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed unanimously.

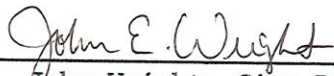
Ordinance No. 90-440, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 70-120, as amended, (Municipal Code Title 13, Chapter 1, Section 13-106), being an ordinance establishing a schedule of rates to be charged for sewer services to be supplied by the sewer system of the City of Goodlettsville, and establishing rules and regulations for the operation thereof, by inserting a new Schedule 3 in Section 1 of said ordinance. Second reading. Motion by Jones to pass on second reading. Seconded by Filson. Passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 90-441, an ordinance to establish \$2500 as the minimum amount of purchase for which sealed bids must be taken. Second reading. Motion by Filson to pass on second reading. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

The Mayor made the following reappointments to various City Boards: Jim Driver and Charlotte Morris to the Planning & Zoning Board; James E. Smith to the Beer Board; Roy Upton to the Park Board; Lloyd Gragg, Trudy Stamper, and Jenny Moss to the Historical & Arts Council; and Johnny Childers to the Hearing Authority. He also announced that Dennis Birdwell and Ted Bloodworth have resigned from the Park Board because their jobs prevent them from attending meetings. Appointments to those positions and to a vacancy on the Hearing Authority will be made at a later meeting.

The City Manager mentioned that Public Works Director Bill Martin has just completed his term as President of the Tennessee Public Works Association and that Parks Director Mike Alsup has received his Masters degree in Parks and Recreation from Western Kentucky University.

The meeting adjourned at 6:38pm.
