The meeting was called to order by Mayor Garrett. Prayer was offered by Bobby Jones. Minutes of the October 25 meeting were approved as written.

Ordinance No. 90-437, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 89-413, as amended (zoning ordinance) by rezoning Parcel 3, Sumner County Tax Map 142 (B. Hitt property, Springfield Highway) from CG (Commercial General) to IG (Industrial General). Public Hearing and second reading. During the public hearing no one spoke for or against the ordinance and the Mayor declared the public hearing closed. Motion by Long to pass on second reading. Seconded by Jones. Passed unanimously.

Ordinance No. 90-438, an ordinance to amend Title I, Chapter 1, Section 1-101, of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code and Ordinance No. 88-407, to temporarily change the regular meeting day from the first and third Thursday to the second and fourth Thursday from November, 1990, through June, 1991. Third reading. Motion by Childers to pass on third reading. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously.

Consider a resolution granting the City of Goodlettsville authority to purchase Federal surplus personal property through the State Department of General Services. Motion by Jones to adopt Resolution No. R90-111. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

Consider authorization of an engineering study regarding long-range plans for sewer services. The City Manager stated that the study would take about ninety days to complete. Motion by Jones to authorize the study. Seconded by Long. Passed unanimously.

Consider a resolution to allow elected officials to participate in the TCRS retirement plan. Motion by Jones to adopt Resolution No. R90-112. Seconded by Childers. Passed unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 6:38pm.
